Since 2003, I have been implementing resource efficient and cleaner production projects in developing countries and transition economies with particular focus on Africa and Asia. In 2008, I had been involved in eco-industrial parks development in China (Hangzhou, Zhejiang province) and India (Dahej, Gujarat State) with the support of Government of Switzerland and University of Lausanne. In 2010, UNIDO started the implementation of eco-industrial parks development in developing countries in close collaboration with UNEP and the global network on Resource Efficient and Cleaner Production (RECP net). In 2015, I became UNIDO focal point on eco-industrial parks development and I was part of the author team of the first global assessment of eco-industrial parks in developing countries published by UNIDO in 2016. This publication provides the status of eco-industrial park development in 33 industrial parks from 13 developing countries. Currently, I am managing the roll-out and upscaling of eco-industrial park development in China, India, Morocco, South Africa, Colombia and Peru.

Since 1994, safeguarding the environment has been at the heart of my professional work. During 1994-2003, I worked in the safety of industrial facilities including the environmental impact assessment of nuclear facilities in Morocco. During my mandate as director of Morocco Cleaner Production Centre (CMPP, 2003-2007), I promoted cleaner production, resource efficiency and corporate social responsibility within the private sector in Morocco represented by CGEM. Since 2007, I have been responsible of promoting UNIDO's mandate on sustainable industrial development in developing countries with focus on Africa and Asia. After the adoption of SDG's 2030, my core business is the promotion of resource efficiency, green industry and circular economy in developing countries.
